The winter festival, Kasuga Wakamiya On-Matsuri has been held since the 12th century for the purpose of praying against disease and epidemic; and later, it has been associated with a good harvest. It takes place between December 15 and 18 every year, and 17th is the highlight. One of the must-see events is the parade, where you can see a thousand people (and fifty horses) dressed in authentically replicated ancient clothings, walking through the heart of Nara city. Other events entail traditional performing arts, which are dedicated to God. Viewing seats are available for your convenience at three venues. Come and experience historical Japanese culture and art live.
